## CIRCUIT IDENTIFICATION:

Appliance wiring material is not required to carry any markers for circuit identification, but such markers may be employed provided they do not conflict in any way (cannot possibly be mistaken for) the original manufacturer's or temperature markers.

The following are acceptable:

- (a) A continuous stripe applied helically to the surface of the insulation.
- (b) A broken stripe or series of dashes applied longitudinally. The breaks in the stripe may be perpendicular or oblique.
- (c) Three or more continuous, longitudinal stripes, provided the temperature rating is indicated by ink printing or by indent printing.
- (d) Printing with Indelible Ink - Contrasting color on thermoplastic insulation or jacket shall be used. The legend shall consist of the manufacturer's name and/or the trade name of the product or the electrical reference number assigned by the Laboratories. The legend shall appear at intervals of 2 ft or less.
